



Attention All Transfer of Property Inspectors of Onsite Wastewater Treatment Systems

Arizona law requires that all Real Estate septic system inspections be done by an ADEQ-approved inspector. This class is sponsored by the University of Arizona, approved by the ADEQ, and successful completion of the two day course results in NAWT and ADEQ certification. Upon certification, your name will be listed on the NAWT website, which is referenced by both Real Estate Agents and property owners for compliance with the Arizona Transfer Inspection Program under AACR18-9-A316. This course is also a pre-requisite for both the Arizona Soil & Site Evaluation for Onsite Wastewater Treatment Systems and Introduction to Design of Onsite Wastewater Treatment Workshops. Also...Re-certification classes can be taken after six months, and add two years of certification. Thus, if you aren't required to re-certify for another year, but take the required class or classes, you then won't need to re-certify for another three years.
